Health News: Connector road at hospital could open in January

A new road will soon connect Eagle Village and Mary Washington Hospital.

My colleague Bill Freehling reported this week on the start of work on the connector road between the Eagle Village center and the Mary Washington Hospital campus in Fredericksburg. The road is expected to be completed in January. Bill's report can be seen here.

Mary Washington Hospital is changing physician groups in its neonatal intensive care unit. Pediatrix, its longtime contractor, will be replaced by the $\,$ Children's National Medical Center. The CNMC doctors will cover the NICU and provide neonatal hospitalist coverage. They start Feb. 1, 2012. CNMC is already at the Fredericksburg hospital as the contractor for pediatric hospitalist services.

Mary Washington Hospice hosted its first "Grapes in the Garden," a wine tasting, at the gardens at Snowden House on Sept. 25. DelFosse Vineyards and Winery, Mattaponi Winery and Lake Anna Winery provided the wine samples. The event sold 154 tickets and raised more than \$12,000 for Mary Washington Hospice.

VHI is a nonprofit organization that collects data about health providers throughout the state. Its 2011 Industry Report, published this week, ranks hospitals in five categories: charges, costs, productivity and utilization, financial viability and community support.

The scores for the three local hospitals were:

Mary Washington Hospital: 2.2

Stafford Hospital: 3.3

Spotsylvania Regional Medical Center: 3.9
