

Related Readmissions

VHI's goal is to develop information that fairly compares hospitals' performance, mortality and readmission outcomes.

In 2004, VHI collaborated with Anthem to develop a methodology to analyze cardiac care including related readmissions.

VHI later worked with a Cardiac Care Expert panel supported by the research of Ramesh K. Shukla, Ph.D., Professor at Virginia Commonwealth University's Department of Health Administration to modify the cardiac care methodology including expansion to report related readmissions.

In May 2006, VHI's Board of Directors approved the list of APRDRGs that counted as related readmissions and as a result, the number of APRDRGs included was reduced. More information on readmissions methodology is available, http://vhi.org/pdf/cardiac_readmission_methodology_explanation.pdf.
